Dynamic Fellows Award (DFA), is a \$1,500.00 financial award for Ten (10) McKinney-Vento Program (MVP) high school seniors attending an Orange County Public School. Applicants must be preparing to enroll in an accredited college or university or vocational institution.

NOTE: Financial funds are awarded to the student upon evidence of registration in an accredited higher educational or vocational institution.

Application submission is February 3, 2025 - March 7, 2025.

Who selects the recipients?

A selection committee will review the applications and make the selections.

How many scholarships will be awarded?

There will be 10, \$1,500.00 scholarships awarded. The scholarship will be awarded in two \$750.00 installments during the Fall and Spring semester of the selected MVP seniors first post-secondary year.

How may the Dynamic Fellows Award Scholarship be used?

Once proof of enrollment in a post-secondary program or vocational school and class selection is provided, the scholarship will be awarded directly to the recipient and can be used to offset the cost of tuition, fees, personal needs and/or books.

When will the scholarship be awarded?

The scholarship is awarded after the add/drop period of the Fall and Spring semester.

Who is eligible for the scholarship?

The Dynamic Fellows Award Scholarship is available to all McKinney-Vento graduating high school seniors in Orange County Public Schools who plan to attend an accredited junior college, college, university, or vocational school.

Application Deadline – March 7, 2025. No applications will be accepted after March 7th, 11:59 pm. Mailed applications must be postmarked by March 7, 2025.



Dynamic Fellows Award Scholarship Guidelines

Dynamic Fellows Award (DFA) is a \$1,500.00 financial award that is awarded to ten (10) McKinney-Vento Program (MVP) high school seniors attending an Orange County Public School. Applicants must be preparing to enroll in an accredited college or university or vocational institution.

NOTE: Financial funds are awarded to the student upon evidence of registration in an accredited higher educational or vocational institution.

Application submission period is February 3, 2025 – March 7, 2025.

Criteria and eligibility (DFA applicants)

1. Applicants must attend High School in "Orange County."
2. Applicants must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
3. Applicants must qualify under the McKinney-Vento Program (MVP) with Orange County Public Schools (OCPS). Verification must come from a school counselor.
4. Applicants must submit a transcript demonstrating a 2.5 or above grade point average.
5. All applicants must submit documentation demonstrating 20 hours of community service hours.
6. Applicants must submit one letter of recommendation (From school counselor, teacher, pastor, etc.).
7. Applicants must choose from one of the topics listed below and write a 2-page essay.

February 3, 2025, application process opens.

March 7, 2025, application deadline.

March 14, 2025, readers select award recipients.

March 26, 2025, award recipients' mandatory finance class.

April 26, 2025, award ceremony.
